INVITATION FOR BID

Notice for Procurement of Works

(First Date of Publication: 2065 / 10 /21)

1. Mahakali Irrigation Management Division No. 8, Bhimduttanagar, Kanchanpur on behalf of Government of Nepal (GON), invites registered Contractors of any class to submit proposals (technical & financial) for the construction works under National Competitive Bidding.
2. A complete set of Qualification and Bid Documents for the work may be purchased from the following offices by interested bidders on the submission of a written request attaching copies of the bidder's registration, renewed Licence, VAT registration certificates, income tax clearance up to FY 064-65 or income tax statements submitted documents, Self declaration of eligibility for bidding, no conflicts of self interest, no punishment regarding contract; upon payment of a non-refundable fee (as specified in para 17 below) until the **30th day** from the first date of publication of this notice for **general contract packages** and **15th day** from the first date of publication of this notice for **special contract packages**.

3. The completed documents must be submitted to the following office on or before 12.00 hours (Noon) of the next day of the last date of purchasing. If the last date of purchasing/submission falls on a Government official holiday, the next working day shall be considered as the last date of purchasing/submission. Documents received after this deadline will not be accepted.

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4. The bid and qualification documents will be opened in presence of the bidders or their authorized representatives who choose to attend at the above-mentioned addresses at 14:00 hours on the last day of submission. The bid & qualification documents shall be evaluated according to The Bidding Documents, Public Procurement Act, 2063 and Public Procurement Regulation, 2064.
5. The substantially responsive bidders (themselves or their authorized representative) shall have to produce their original documents (work experience certificates, financial statements and owner's books for all proposed plants, equipments and vehicles including those being leased or rented etc. as demanded by the document).
6. Bids must be accompanied with an earnest money of 2.5% of the Bid amount in the form of Bank Voucher deposited in account no 324-Kha-3, Dharauti at Rastriya Banijya Bank, Bhimduttanagar Branch, Bhimduttanagar or Bank Guarantee drawn in favour of Mahakali Irrigation Management Division No. 8. Management Division having a validity period as mentioned below from the last date of submission of the qualification and bid documents. Bank Guarantee issued by any Finance Company shall not be accepted.
7. Each bidder who is applying for the work package, either individually or as a joint venture partner shall duly fill "Priority List of Work Packages Applied for".

8. If any of the information data submitted by the bidder in the documents be unclear and not substantiated by supporting documents, such information shall not be considered for evaluation.
9. Interested Bidders may obtain further information from the offices mentioned above. Bidders are requested to visit the site and assess the actual site conditions before submitting their bid.
10. The unit price furnished in words shall prevail in case of any discrepancy between figures and words.
11. Bidders shall provide Rate Analysis of main items as mentioned in BOQ, except for special packages.
12. The successful bidders for special packages shall be notified by telephone and fax acknowledgement of receipt of notice shall not be necessary.
13. The successful bidders are required to be present within seven days of notification for contract agreement with required documents, failure to do so shall not be considered.
14. The contractor appointed for the special packages shall start the field work within seven days from the date of agreement with necessary personnel, equipment and other necessary arrangements.
15. The physical work progress of the special contract packages shall be at least 15% at 25% of contract time period, 50% at 50% of contact time period and 100% at 90% of contract time period. If the contractor fails to make such progress, the contractor shall pay damages at the rate of 0.05% of contract price per day to up to 10% of contract price as a maximum damages.
16. The Project reserves the right to accept or reject any or all bids without assigning any reason whatsoever.
17. Any Bidder may apply for the work listed below either by himself or as a partner in joint venture provided that each joint venture (JV) partner has purchased a complete set of qualification and bid documents separately. However, if joint venture documents are produced during purchasing the documents, the joint venture firm will be treated as a single entity and the joint venture (JV) partners need not purchase the set of documents separately.
